The following types of events are not eligible for the Community Events Calendar:

- Events of illegal or immoral nature
- Retail store sales and promotions
- Events that conflict with the intent of the event calendar
- Personal fundraisers
- Special meetings (such as Annual General Meetings)
- Free information workshops to solicit clients
- No advertising. No garage sales. No classified ads.
- Events that negatively target specific organizations or individuals
