10:00 am Learn how to identify birds using field guides and other resources. Take a walk through Besser Natural Area to test your skills. Bring binoculars and field guides if you have them.
- 10:30 am- Mountain Bike Safari to the Sinkholes-Rockport Harbor  
12:00 pm Provide your own mountain bike. Helmet and water is suggested. Starting at the parking lot near the Big Tent, bikers will head out to Overburden Lookout, then loop back through the quarry and out to the sinkholes.
